

The Indonesian Constitutional Court Ruling on the Omnibus Law: Unconstitutional with Conditions?

On the 25th of November 2021, under its final and binding ruling No. 91/PUU-XVIII/2020, the Indonesian Constitutional Court (*Mahkamah Konstitusi*) ruled on an application for a judicial review of Law No. 11 of 2020 on Job Creation (commonly known as the “**Omnibus Law**”). The Court concluded that the formation of the Omnibus Law is procedurally flawed (*cacat formil*). In this advisory, we outline the notable verdicts and the possible implications of Ruling No. 91/PUU-XVIII/2020.
